Shamisen Japanese Banjo Lesson (TM01)

Write your name and motto in Japanese artistically with a writing brush, using sumi black ink on Japanese washi paper and hang them on your wall when you return to home.



Furoshiki Cloth Wrapping (TC08)

Furoshiki is square cloth used to transport gifts, lunches, sake bottles, books or almost anything. Furoshiki is not just a square cloth but a quite creative and ecological tool which can be made into a hat and or a bag by folding it
